TOWN MILL – LYME REGIS

The Town Mill is open to the public through the efforts of local volunteers. These volunteers are active millers, shop or garden volunteers who give their time to either improve the look of the mill, run the shop open to the public or take visitors on tours around the mill and work it to produce flour. Miller training involves 6 half day sessions covering the workings of the mill, its history and health and safety issues. The shop involves handling money, the till, pricing, presentation, being the first point of contact for visitors and the garden volunteers are led by a Trustee who has researched the history of the Miller's garden.
